- V. Superintendent's Report
 - A. Interlocal Agreement from Grayson County SPED Cooperative 10 districts left in the Co-Op. Slowly losing districts as they grow and are able to house their own. Pottsboro will be leaving next and Whitesboro will be close behind. New fiscal agent will be Collinsville ISD starting with the 2025-2026 school year. New Interlocal agreement will be presented for action in December.
 - B. **Property Tax Changes Within Tioga ISD Boundaries** discussed changes and how GCAD/Shawn Coker's office will roll back 3 years for new subdivisions.
 - C. Tioga Meadows Development Craig Calhoun (Dev.) & Jerry Sylo (JBI) City of Tioga has approved this new subdivision. Developers wanted to get the school district involved asap. The development will donate 13.9 acres of the development for a future Tioga ISD school site.

FCCLA "Light Up Tioga" program will be taking place at the Tioga Christmas Tree Lighting event on December 7th. Football season ended last Friday night. Had a great season ending at 9 – 3. Girls Basketball has already had early season success. Benchmark testing coming up at end of the semester. Seven students will graduate in December from Grayson College with their Associates degree a semester early.
 - Mrs. Hansen / Pre-K-4th Grade Current enrollment for Pre-K through 4th grade 219. Attendance at 95%. Kindergarten just had their Friends Feast, 1st grade Christmas Program is on December 6th, 3rd Grade working on math and language arts TEKS. Our Veterans Day program was a huge success. UIL Competition coming up next week in Chico. It's been a great semester so far.
 - Mrs. Moore / 5th-7th Grade Just wrapped up our Food Drive with 2,829 items donated. Ms. Barnet's 5th Grade has buddied up with Ms. G's Kindergarten class for literacy buddies. Testing for middle of the year benchmark will be completed before Christmas break. Accelerated Reading program students are working diligently each student has to read at least 5 books and test.
